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## Cell Phone Policy Grades Pre-K thru 5<sup>th</sup> Grade

Chancellor’s Regulation A-413 establishes a new policy in which the *possession of cell phones, computing devices, and portable music and entertainment systems are permitted in schools. However, each school must establish a school-based policy regarding the use of such items on school property.* Our policy at PS/IS 76 meets the Chancellor’s objective by permitting students to bring cell phones and other electronic devices into the school building: **however, we do recommend that your child does not bring in a cell phone or other electronic devices as it will not be utilized during the school day. Please note that all electronics including cell phone devices should be turned off and stored in their backpacks. Any electronic device, including cell phones, seen or used at any time during the school day will be taken away.**

Confiscated items will be returned *based on the numbers of infractions:*

- 1<sup>st</sup> offense: The teacher will hold it until the end of the day with a warning.*
- 2<sup>nd</sup> offense: The phone will be given to administration for the child to pick it up.*
- 3<sup>rd</sup> offense: The phone will be given to administration and **MUST BE COLLECTED BY A PARENT AND/OR GUARDIAN.***

**\*\*PS/IS 76 will NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE for cell phones and other electronic devices brought from home.**

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## Cell Phone Policy Grades 6th thru 8th

Chancellor's Regulation A-413 establishes a new policy in which the *possession of cell phones, computing devices, and portable music and entertainment systems is permitted in schools. However, each school must establish a school-based policy regarding the use of such items on school property.* Our policy at PS/IS 76 meets the Chancellor's objective by permitting students to bring cell phones and other electronic devices into the school building: **but all electronics including cell phone devices will be collected at the start of the school day; any electronic device including cell phone seen or used at any time during the school day will be taken away. Parents will be notified. Parents can come and pick up the item at any time during the day.**

Please discuss the Chancellor's Regulation with your children and remind them regularly to turn in (grades 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>) their cell phone and all other electronic devices upon entering the school building. Thank you for your cooperation,
